Cruises may last up to 2 hours

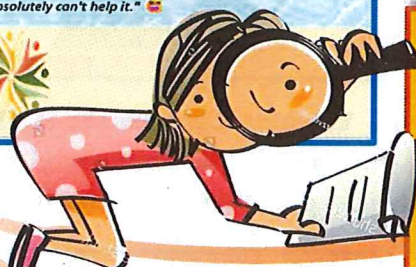
Pontoon boats are wonderful inventions. Bathrooms are generally not included
